Derek was the English Schools Race Walking Secretary who attended many RWA General Committee Meetings and AGMs as a co-opted member of the Officers and Management of the RWA.

He was committed to and ever present at ESAA Race Walking Championships and always liaised with the RWA regarding the appointment of race walk judges for schools' walks.



National Results

Bethan Davies set a new British Record of 3:00:24 on her debut over 35km, the new distance at international championships.

Despite the breezy conditions which made racing tough going, Bethan made a very impressive step up from the 20km distance.

She set off in the company of Finland's Elisa Neuvonen who was also making her debut over the distance. Bethan passed the 10km mark in 50:15 as she held a small lead over Neuvonen (50:49). She slowed slightly over the next 10km (50:48) to pass the 20km mark in 1:41:03 as she increased her lead over the Finn to over a minute. The tough conditions and moving into unknown territory began to take is toll with Davies slowing to 5km splits of 25:57 between 20 and 25km and 26:21 between 25km and 30km as she continued to hold her lead over Neuvonen of one minute 30 seconds. Davies found the last 5km tough clocking 27:01 and drifting just outside the three hour mark. She came home to set the new British Record with Neuvonen setting a new Finnish Record of 3:01:33.

In the 10km, Christian Hopper moved to second on the UK Under 20 rankings for 2021 with a great debut performance over the distance of 50:41. Millie Morris was the first under 20 women over 10km clocking 54:03 just getting the better of Hannah Hopper who clocked a personal best of 54:04 to also move to second on the UK Under 20 rankings for 2021.

Taunton's Abby Hughes was the overall winner of the 5km race in a season's best of 26:22. Ellis Simmonds made his debut over 5km and recorded a satisfactory 28:07.
